- And most importantly – I am thankful for all of the friends and associates I have. (Truthfully, most of my social life revolves around the OCPA club and the people I've met through the club.)

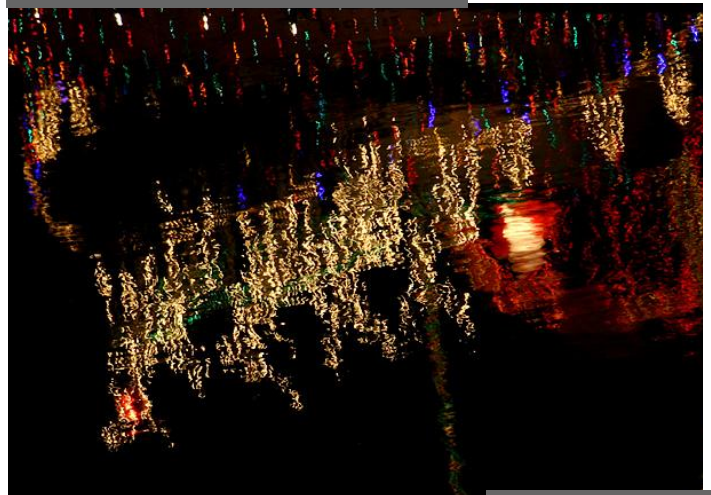

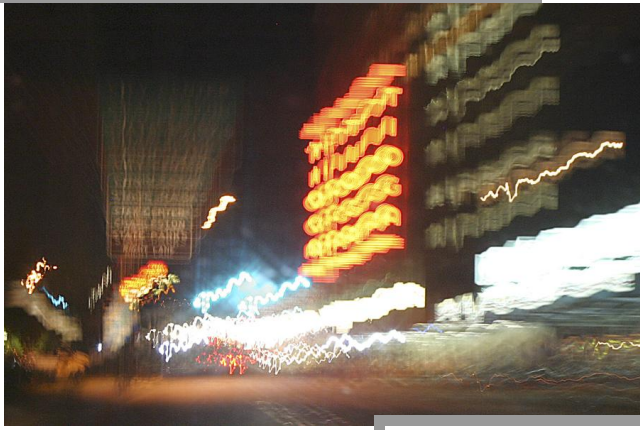
