18 members assisted by handling the exhibit booth and watching over the display. As well as all the contributors noted above Nancy and Jerry Brouhard, Kathy Chambers, Judy Lochman, Ron Lyons, Neil McKown and Carol Schuldt helped out in this area.

We sold 23 images for a total value of \$453 during the Show, not bad in this economy. Dick and Tony led the list with 6 sales each. The Club gets 10% of sales so \$45.30 went to our Treasury. In addition, one membership was also sold.

Special thanks to Don Todd for doing the legwork organizing the Show and dealing with the Mall personnel and keeping things going smoothly.
