## OCPA 4C'S NOVEMBER EID RESULTS by Tony Mason

After 2 competitions, OCPA stands in 14th Place (out of 18) with 181 total points. The 1st Place club (Yaquina) has 213 total points. Juried by Monticello Camera Club, 95 images were submitted in November - meaning 9 images would receive an AM and 3 a HM. Two images received a 26 and 4 a 23. Next score down was 22 with 5 of them going to AM's and 3 to HM's. Unfortunately Curt's image, which also received a 22, was not included in the winners (via a tie break).

## *Trivia Corner by Curt Benward*

*How did Leica get its name and what railroad did they run?*

*Leica Camera AG is a well known Germany company that makes quality cameras. They made their first 35mm camera in 1913. The Leica name comes from the first three letters of the surname of the company's founder, Ernst Leitz and the first two letters from the word camera. A truly innovative company they developed the first practical 35mm camera using standard cinema film. To get a negative large enough to produce quality negatives, they transformed the 18 x 24mm cinema film transported vertically to a 24 x 36mm film transported horizontally. The rest is film history.*

*As innovative as their camera technology was their employment practices. The optic and camera work required a very skilled workforce. To retain skilled workers, Leica instituted pensions, sick leave and health insurance long before most companies.*

*Many of Leica's employees were Jewish. When Adolf Hitler became chancellor, Ernst Leitz II helped Jews leave Germany covertly by assigning them to overseas Leica offices as employees.*

*When these German Jews arrived at the Leica New York office, they were given a Leica camera and a stipend until they could find work. After Kristallnacht in 1938, the movement of Jews out of Germany by Leitz increased to such a degree it was called the "Leica Freedom Train". Not a bad railroad to run.*

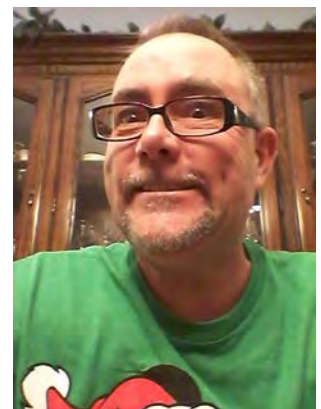

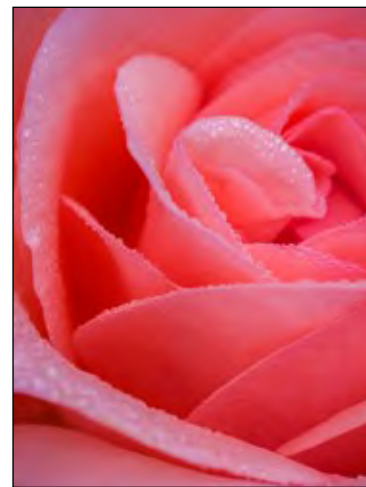

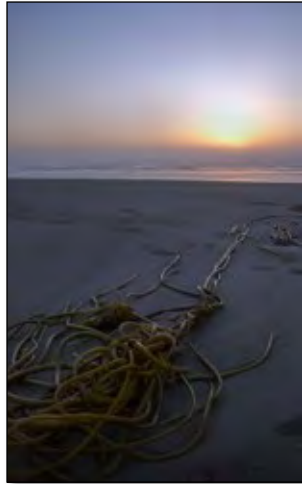
