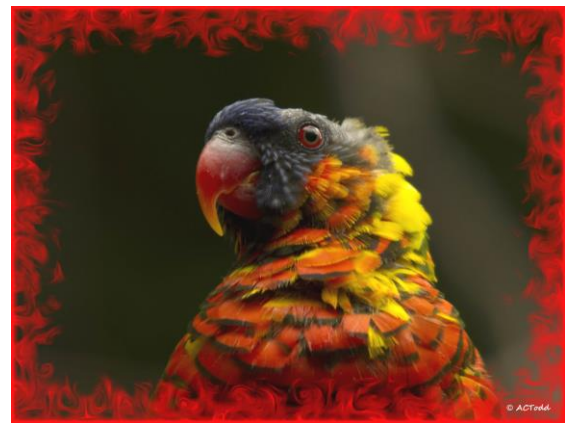
Changes are Coming

<p>March's 4Cs Electronic Interclub Competition was juried by Forest Grove Camera Club. 100 images were submitted by 19 clubs. The average total score for a club was 93.3 with the average score for an individual image of 18.6 (average judge score was 6.2). The 10 Award of Merit images needed a score of 23 (one image received), 22 (five images) or 21 (the balance of 4). All three of the Honorable Mention winners had a score of 21 (meaning our Elise's "Cat Eyes" could of been a winner but did not survive the tie break). OCPA is currently in 17th place with 467 total points, out of the 20 eligible clubs (current high total is 614 points).</p>
