File (Image) Specifications:

- All files in the JPEG format
- Images will be no larger than 1400 pixels on the horizontal side and 1050 on the vertical Side (same as competition photos)
- Files must not exceed 1 MB
- Use of the sRGB color space recommended, but not required
- File naming (example): 01_Joe Photographer.jpeg
- Turn in all entries by November 4th with \$2 Entry Fee

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THE RULES (almost anything goes):

- NEW PHOTOS TAKEN DURING THE SCAVENGER HUNT PERIOD
- Images may be edited
- No clip art or text (unless it is a part of the photograph, i.e. on a sign etc.)
- The entry fee is \$2 per member and is due by the turn-in date. Only members in good standing may participate.

TIMELINE:

- October 7, 2019 – 6:30 PM: The Scavenger Hunt begins
- November 4, 2019 – 6:30 PM: All image files must be turned in at the meeting (if not before via email to pomescarol@yahoo.com email must be dated before 6:30 pm, 11/4/19) and entry fee paid (\$2 per member)
- November 21, 2019 – The Judging
- December 2, 2019 – Winner Presentation

FILE (IMAGE) SPECIFICATIONS:

- All files in the JPEG format
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(the two-digit number of the category, underscore, your first and last name, spaces between your names is ok and recommended. Do not add any other title or description.)

HINTS:

- The spelling of the category subject does not count, it is how it is pronounced (for example red or read).
- Use your imagination and be creative on these song and movie titles.
- When judging, the priority will be given to how the image fits the category/subject, then on how well it is photographed. A gorgeous image will not score well if the audience does not understand how it fits the category/subject.
- Remember the audience will have a limited amount of time to judge your photo
