April 2018 meeting minutes were approved unanimously with Kathy Chambers motioning to accept minutes as posted in the newsletter and Bonnie Smith seconding Kathy's motion.

Treasurer's Report: Beginning Balance was 1403.15. Current Balance is \$1452.75. Income from Pony Village Sale was 28.60 and \$17.00 from raffle for prints.
