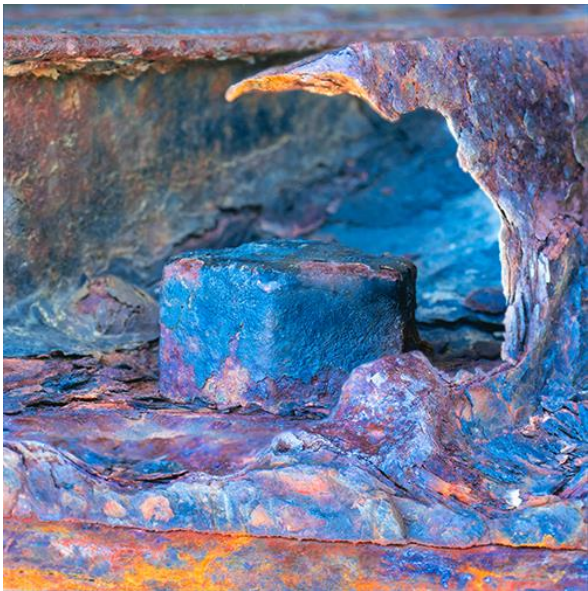

BOARD MEETING MINUTES:

OCPA Board Meeting Minutes August 2018

August 13, 2018, 6:32 P.M. the meeting was called to order by President Renee Marcov at The Chamber's home. Members present were: Bonnie Smith, Don Todd, Carol Pomes, Tony Mason, Kathy Chambers, and Dick Chambers. Guests present were Elise Ciraolo and Carol Todd.

Carol P moved to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as written, Bonnie S seconded and the motion carried.

Due to the absence of the Treasurer, Carol T gave the Treasurer's report. Expenses were: \$48 for the youth awards at the fair and \$250 for insurance. Income was \$147 in dues. Ending balance was \$2229.85. Don moved, and Tony seconded to accept the Treasurer's report.

Susan Chambers has donated \$60 towards our new meeting place which charges \$15 per meeting time. Thank you, Susan!

Carol T presented an updated member list. After discussion, there are a few members to add to the list.

4C's Conference -We need to set up a budget for the convention. We have 4 free tickets to the convention. Tickets will go to Elise, Bonnie G, and Renee. The 4th ticket will be raffled off to our membership for \$1 a ticket or 6 for \$5. We will sell tickets for the next two meetings.

Carol P will be working on the Facebook Chatter site. She is also collecting images of people taking photos and working on a video for convention.

There will be a 4C's Convention meeting tomorrow, 1:00 P.M., at The Todd's to work on birdhouses which will be the table decorations.

Pony Village - Hanging will be November 14th and the Show/Sale will be the 15th through the 18th.

Shootouts - There is a Coquille shootout coming up the 25th of August along with the BBQ at Thomas Konomos' home at 370 N. Collier. It was discussed and agreed to cancel the shootout scheduled for October 13th immediately following the convention.

Website- Elise reported that she has a new version of Acrobat and will get the website updated with new information in the next few days. She is getting photos organized for the field trips for the Convention. She would still like to do a member's gallery with 3 to 5 images by each member.

Art by The Bay - Carol P reported on the upcoming show/sale at Winchester Bay on September 1st and 2nd. Setup will be Friday at 2:00 P.M., Saturday hours will be 10-6 and Sunday will be 10-4 with take down beginning at 4. The items needed for the show/sale were discussed: banner, flip bins, cash box, inventory sheets, PayPal cube which will be setup and connected to our bank account and a membership flyer to hand out. Carol P will also need other members present to help with the show/sale. We are borrowing quilt hanging racks from Coos Sand and Sea Quilters to hang images on. As a courtesy we will hang and sell tickets on their raffle quilt.

Old Business - After discussion it was decided that the Treasurer pay for a year in advance for our meeting place at the North Bend Senior Center. This will be through our annual meeting July of 2019. Carol P is the only person who has the key and code to get into the building and we need a second person. Renee volunteered. For the meetings we need to move tables and set up chairs in a different manner for better sight and hearing for the membership.

New Business -Image size for competition was revisited and it was decided to keep it the same, **1080 on the long side and 1MB in size**. Other entries don't have to abide by this, only competition.

The yearly budget was discussed and roughed out. Carol P moved, and Bonnie seconded to accept the budget, motion carried. It should be available in the September Proof Sheet.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned at 8:17 P.M.
